



Elmhurst Club - 2022 Local Guest and Party Policies

This policy does not apply to non-resident overnight house guests or Temporary Members as defined in the Club Rules for 2022.

Local guests:

- all guests are subject to member pool rules
- either the attending member or the guest must be at least 15 years old
- member families are limited to **four (4) guests per day**
- guest cards can be purchased online, from the club secretary, or at the pool
- the **maximum number of guests** per member family for each summer is twenty (20)
- guest cards are **non-transferable** from one family to another; and are **non-refundable**
- unused 2021 guest punches may be used during the 2022 season
- no single passes or cards with fewer than five (5) units will be sold
- guest passes purchased by check are not mailed; they are available for pick up at the sign-in table at the pool, usually within three (3) days
- **a non-member living within a member's household** for longer than two weeks cannot attend the pool using the guest pass of any member; this person must apply for membership under the current procedure (the member resided with cannot be used as a sponsor) or be added to the member's membership, if appropriate. In either case, member/initiation fees must be paid.
- **members will be responsible for keeping their own guest cards and must bring them to the pool with their guest – guests will not be admitted without a valid guest card**
- guest cards will be punched with each use
- guest cards can be used at any time during regular pool hours
- Members are responsible for the actions of their guests at all times. Should the guest actions not be in accordance with member policies, the guests may be asked to leave the premises. Additionally, repeated offenses by guests may cause further disciplinary action up to and including revocation of the membership for the sponsoring party.

Violations:

1st violation

- \$25 fine
- family membership is suspended until fine is paid

2nd violation

- family membership is suspended for remainder of swim season

Parties:

- party dates must be arranged with the pool manager with a minimum of one week's notice
- once the date has been approved, applications for parties may be downloaded from the Website (ElmhurstSwimClub.com) and sent or given to the pool manager with payments; all



- payments must be made to, and confirmation secured from, the pool manager before the party can be held; Lifeguards are not permitted to accept applications or payments.
- there is a \$150.00 fee per party plus a \$75.00 security and clean-up deposit (**payable in two separate checks, each made payable to “Elmhurst Swim Club”; memo “party”**)
 - if the grounds are left clean and rubbish is removed to the dumpster, the deposit will be returned
 - guest cards will not be punched for those guests attending a party
 - guests attending a party must sign in at the sign-in table
 - **no more than 20 non-members are permitted to attend a party – this includes parents who attend with their children.** Club members attending the party will not be considered as part of the 20 allowed people.
 - parties may be held between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. only
 - parties may be held on weekdays, Saturdays, and Sundays; parties may not be held on evenings when a home swim meet is scheduled or when family nights are scheduled
 - no alcoholic beverages or beer are permitted at parties on Elmhurst Club property
