



Elmhurst Club Rules

Member Classifications: Adult (15 years and older), Junior (11-15), Children (1-11) Infant (under 1 year). A member changes from one age classification to another for the entire summer if their birthday falls BEFORE Labor Day.

Children: child members are not permitted on premises unless accompanied by an adult member or non-member with a valid Babysitter Pass. Junior members are subject to the same rules, but may also be allowed on premises after passing a swim test and submission of Junior Member Contact and Permission Form (see elmhurstswimclub.com)

Opening Day: Elmhurst opens the Saturday of Memorial Day and closes on Labor Day weather permitting.

Hours: 11:00 AM - 9:00 PM - Monday - Friday
10:00 AM - 9:00 PM - Saturday, Sunday and Holiday

Arriving at Pool: member and guests must sign in; introduce guests to a lifeguard
Compliance: all members must abide by the rules and insist on their enforcement. Parents must assure their children are aware of, and comply with, all rules. Members must be respectful of each other, our Pool Manager and our Lifeguards.

Swimmers: swimmers are those who meet the standards designated by the lifeguards. Standards shall be posted on the bulletin board. Non swimmers are not permitted in the deep end of the pool.

Babysitters: non-member babysitters are permitted to accompany children and/or junior members, in the absence of their member parents/guardians, upon presentation of a current, valid Babysitter pass (non-transferable)

Safety: Games must not interfere with other swimmers. No rafts, inflated toys or ball games are allowed in the deep end. The use of balls, rafts and other toys are at the discretion of the pool manager.

Alcohol/Smoking: Alcohol and smoking (including e-cigarettes and vaping) are not permitted on premises, including the parking lot.

Keep Pool Clean: no pets on premises. Clean up garbage and take home all towels, toys, swimsuits, etc.

Membership: membership is presently closed. Application instructions are available on our website.

Guest policy: members are responsible for the actions of their guests at all times. Should the guest actions not be in accordance with member policies, the guests may be asked to leave the premises. Additionally, repeated offenses by guests may cause further disciplinary actions up to and including revocation of the membership for the sponsoring party.

Discipline: the following Code of Discipline will be strictly enforced:

First offense: 1 week suspension

Second offense: 3 day suspension with letter sent to adult member/parent

Third offense: 1 week suspension with Board option to terminate
Membership with no refund.

We encourage all child members to take swimming lessons.
